

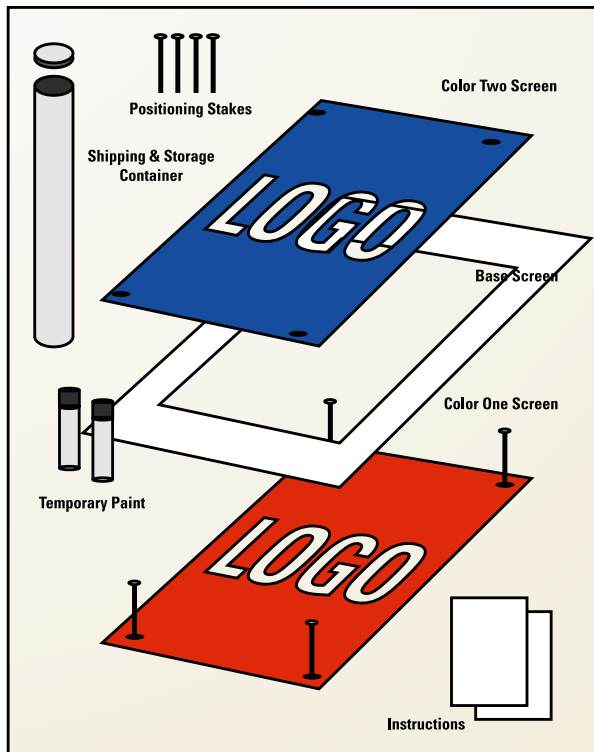


## SUMMARY OF THE PROCESS

**FANatic Art™**, is a unique screen printing process and kit for lawns, grassy areas, driveways, or other outdoor surfaces. The FANatic Art screen printing kit is intended to create a more simplistic format in which to **apply and remove** a single or multi color design or logo to an outdoor or other non traditional surface.

### The Kit Will Consist of:

- 1). Shipping and Storage Container
- 2). Single or multiple screens with grommets
- 3). Base Screen
- 4). 4 (Four) Stakes
- 5). Single or multiple cans of removable paint or Temporary Paint
- 6). Paint Remover if applicable
- 7). Instructions



## APPLICATION PROCESS

### Step 1:

First choose the type of surface on which to place the design or logo. Make sure the surface is clean, dry and free of debris. On a hard surface such as a concrete or asphalt make sure the area is thoroughly swept clean.

Grass preparation: It is recommended that the grass be watered well a day or two before application. It is best that the grass be cut short, about one inch is best. You may rake the designated area before and after cutting. (It is best that the grassy area is thick and green). Make sure grass clippings are removed from the area and the grass is dry.

### Step 2:

Unroll each screen and lay out on a flat surface. Let the screen or screens set for a few minutes in order for them to flatten out if they have been rolled up. If it is cold outside it may be best to lay the screen out inside or in a warm area before take outside to apply. You may smooth and flatten out with you hands. Each Screen may be numbered as to which to lie down and paint first. Generally you would spray down lighter colors first.

### Step 3:

If using a base color, lay out the base pattern flat and smooth. Complete the cut out of base and remove center section. Lay heavy objects such as rocks or bricks on the corners to hold in place. This may be more difficult on windy days and will take more care with the entire application process. The process may be easier with two people. Leave base pattern in place when applying other screens.

#### **Step 4:**

Lay screen number one on the area in which the design or logo is to be placed. With the 4 (Four) stakes, stretch the screen and place the stakes through the 4 (four) grommet wholes and into the ground to hold the screen in place. The stakes are not to hold the screen down, but to make each color fall in the proper location. If you are applying the design on a surface where the stakes can not be used you may wish to hold the screen down with something heavy such as a rock or brick. With your hands smooth out any ripples in the screens and make sure they lay flat and smooth on the ground. On a lawn you may press the screens down evenly into the grass.

\* Please use caution when handling stakes; sharp objects can be harmful and cause damage if used improperly.

#### **Step 5:**

Take a spray can of FANatic Art Removable Temporary Paint (**Shake Very Well**) that corresponds with the color of the current screen and design or logo. Holding the can straight up and down 3 to 5 inches from the screens, spray the FANatic Art Removable Paint or Temporary Paint through the mesh of the first screen. Following the screen design, apply the FANatic Art Removable Paint or Temporary Paint evenly until the area is covered. Do not over spray as the FANatic Art Removable Temporary Paint may run. If applying the design or Logo to a surface where the stakes can not be used, spray the FANatic Art Removable Paint or Temporary Paint through the grommet wholes. This will give you a guide to lay additional screens.

Leaving the stakes in place, gently remove the first screen. Allowing 5 to 10 minutes for the first color to dry, lay the second screen over the stakes directly on top of the first area painted. Or line up the paint dots from the first screen with the grommet wholes of the second screen.

Repeat this process until all colors of the design have been painted.

Once the final screen is removed your design or logo is complete.

## **REMOVAL PROCESS**

Depending on the FANatic Art Removable Paint or Temporary Paint used, the design or logo will remain on the surface as long as desired. And can be removed with the application of the remover and or soap and water and a brush or stiff broom. If using the FANatic Art™ Temporary Paint the design is very temporary and can be cleaned up with soap and water or will begin to fade and wash away with rain, water and traffic over the surface.

If using FANatic Art Temporary Paint, Wet down the design with water. Using dish soap or other safe household soap, scrub the design with a brush or stiff broom and plenty of water and spray away with hose. If residue remains repeat the process.

If using FANatic Art Removable Paint

Apply the remover liberally. Agitate or scrub with a broom or brush and wash away with plenty of water or garden hose. If residue remains repeat the process.

Grass application may also be allowed to grow out and cut with a mower, to remove the design or logo.

## **CLEAN UP**

Clean screens thoroughly soon after use. If removable paint is used, spray remover on the screens and gently scrub with a broom or brush and wash away with plenty of water and/or garden hose. For Temporary Paint clean screens in the same manner. Thoroughly but gently scrub with a broom or brush and wash away with plenty of water and/or garden hose and soap and water.

*It is recommended the screens be cleaned outdoors.  
Hang or lay flat to dry.*

## IMPORTANT SCREEN CARE

When storing Screens, roll Screens with design and vinyl out, around the tube included in your kit. Do not store or roll screens together wet or with wet paint.

Clean screens after use as soon as practical. Screens may be hung on a garage wall to dry, or gently wiped down with a dry towel. Once dry, if any areas of the vinyl are beginning to delaminate from screen, you can use a hairdryer to heat the vinyl so it will adhere back to the screen.

## IMPORTANT NOTICE

Only use FANatic Art recommended paints. The use of any other paints may permanently destroy or damage screens and may harm or kill grass and/or damage other surfaces.
